

SERMON INFO

Today's *City on a Hill* lesson focuses on anger. Scripture says a great deal about anger. One of the main passages is James 1:20, which says "Phil will give us two key strategies to aid us in handling our anger."

CITY ON A HILL

Questions for Reflection & Discussion

- When have you been the most angry in the last month?
- Someone makes a decision you disagree with (child's school plans, family member's COVID philosophy, relative's travel plans, legislature's policy, etc.). How long will you stay angry?
- When was a moment when your anger caused quite the negative impact in your world?
- Do you think it's possible to be in close proximity to someone who irritates you, without letting their dysfunction become your own? Why or why not?
- Is there such a thing as "righteous anger"? When would anger be justifiable?
- Jesus seems angry at the temple. Do you think He was? If so, what made His anger justifiable? What would be accurate modern day applications of this text?
- Do you normally handle anger more like "Option 1" or "Option 2" from the illustration in the sermon?
- Which of two main strategies did you resonate with the most? (Choose to be unoffendable. Expect fallen people to be fallen people.)
