they become so familiar we lose perspective on their power. Today I'm starting a series to remind us of what I believe is the greatest promise in the Bible. It's called the Immanuel promise, and it's just a few words: God is with us. You've heard those words before. You've probably heard them a lot. But, just like my girls can lose sight of what it means that they're beautiful, so we can lose sight of what it means that God is with us. In the valley, in the dark, on the mountain, in the moment, in a pandemic, I need this promise. You need this promise.

- Do you find it easier to seek and find the presence of God on the mountain or in the valley?
