



Today is Missions Sunday, and we anticipate great things as we take up a special offering for our mission efforts around the world. Many have been working hard behind the scenes to prepare for our special congregational event this week—a reverse parade, which will follow our worship service and take place in the east parking lot. Phil's sermon will set up this experience. He will talk about the importance in scripture of cross-cultural Christian connection.
