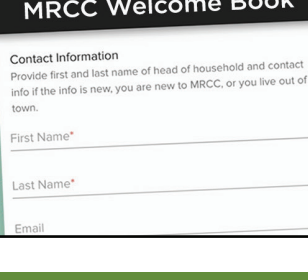

Firm Foundations

COVID-19 and its impact on the Edmond Public Schools' schedule has created some tremendous difficulties for many families with limited financial resources and few options for daytime help with their children. *Firm Foundations* is a new MRCC ministry with the goal of offering enrichment and tutoring support to Edmond families that need help the most. The program will operate from 9 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays at MRCC. If you have just 1-2 hours a week, you can help make this a fantastic year for children who need a safe, fun place to learn!

Firm Foundations begins Wednesday, Sept. 9, and a variety of timeslots are available. Our biggest need is TUTORs (no previous teaching experience necessary), but there are also non-tutor positions to be filled. Two certified teachers will be on-site and provide in-person classroom instruction for half the day. During the other half of the day, our volunteer tutors will meet with very small groups of K-4th grade students to help them successfully complete their online assignments.

Every volunteer must submit to a background check. This is a simple process of completing a form via a link we will send you. The health and safety of our volunteers and students is a high priority. *Firm Foundations* will follow COVID protocols consistent with Edmond Public Schools. Students, volunteers and staff will wear masks indoors and social distancing guidelines will be followed. Thanks to the size of the program (only 48 students) and the size of our facility, there will be room to spread out and students will be outside as often as possible. Chapel, lunch and recess will be a fun part of each day.

SERMON INFO



This morning, Phil plans to wrap up our *Reimagine* intro series with a lesson called "Reimagine Joy." Joy seems to be one of the most elusive things in life. Every time we feel like we have it, it just seems to float away. Elijah had a moment in his life where it seemed all the joy had evaporated. He was stuck, alone in a cave, wishing he were dead. And then God showed up. God displayed His profound wisdom in how He handled Elijah's despondency. Phil will explore the multidimensional nature of God's care for Elijah, and explain why this kind of care is vital today for our own pursuit of joy.

- What do you think is the most common source for your "blah" days of late?
- How is the Christian worldview poised to respond to a world in pain in comparison to other worldviews?

- Which area of your life do you feel needs the most attention: body, social life, or spiritual life?
- What's present in the earthquake, wind, or fire, but rather in the gentle whisper. What are some ways to apply this to your life today?
- When you are the best version of yourself, how do you interact with the world?
