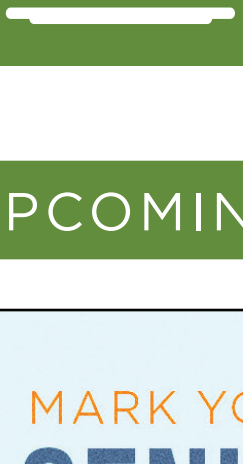

First Cup is a chance for newcomers to learn more about MRCC. First Cup happens every Sunday at 9:35 a.m. in the Conference Room.

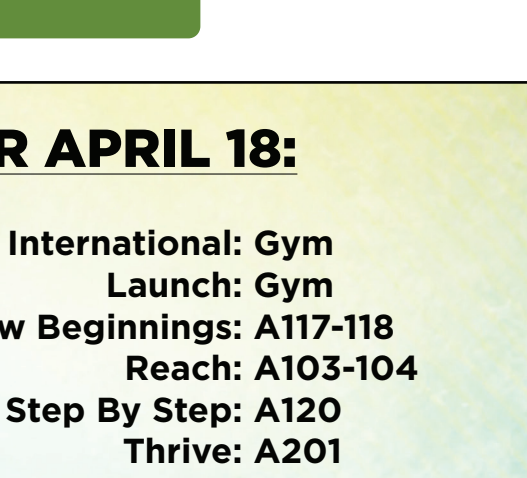

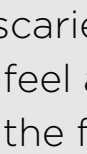
COVID-19 Protocol Reminders

Physically distance yourself from people not in your household. During worship, please sit in the blue marked pews.



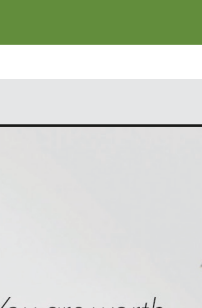
Bring communion from home.

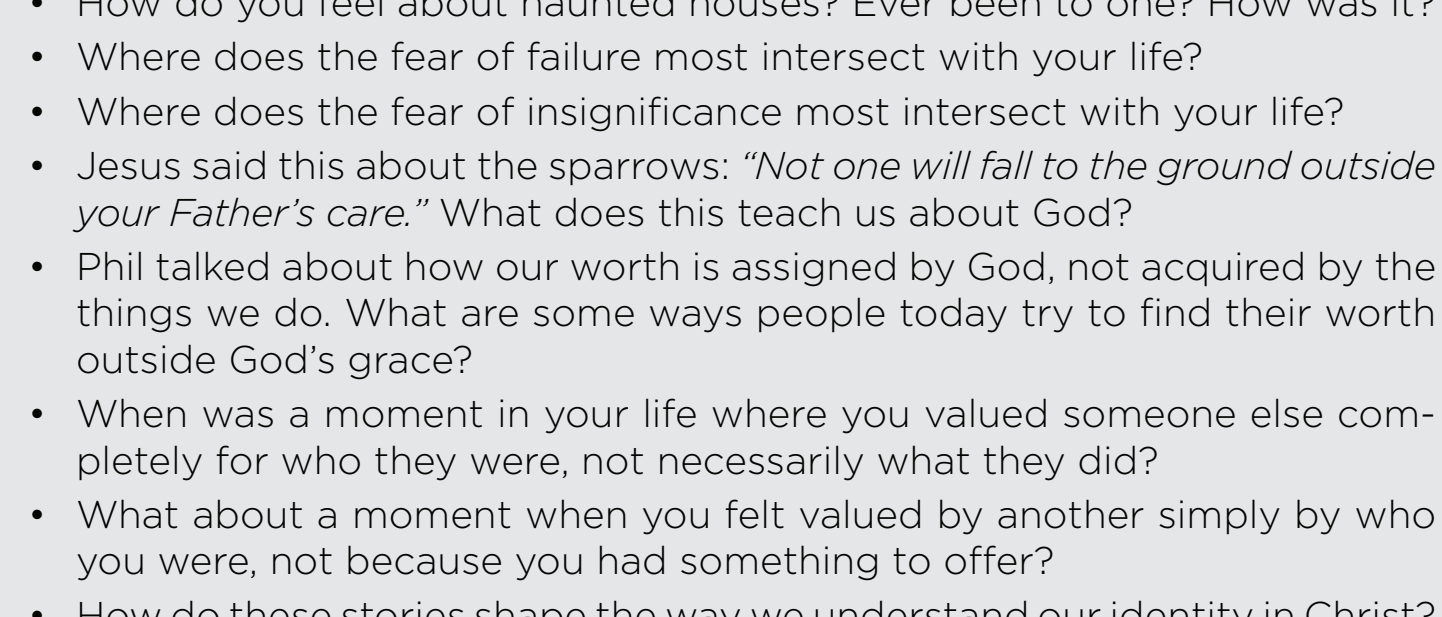

Questions for Reflection & Discussion

- What is the scariest movie you've ever seen?
- How do you feel about haunted houses? Ever been to one? How was it?
- Where does the fear of failure most intersect with your life?
- Where does the fear of insignificance most intersect with your life?
- Jesus said this about the sparrows: "Not one will fall to the ground outside your Father's care." What does this teach us about God?
- Phil talked about how our worth is assigned by God, not acquired by the things we do. What are some ways people today try to find their worth outside God's grace?
- When was a moment in your life where you valued someone else completely for who they were, not necessarily what they did?
- What about a moment when you felt valued by another simply by who you were, not because you had something to offer?
- How do these stories shape the way we understand our identity in Christ?

There are so many fears that consume our thoughts and hearts. Last week, as a part of our current sermon series, Phil asked us to share our fears anonymously via text message. From those texts, we compiled the most common fears and have developed a resource board in the foyer with the goal of encouraging you. You are not alone in your fears; and, as Jesus followers, we can learn so much from His teachings to help deal with them in practical ways. 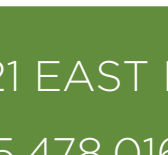
New Baby
