






## Please join us for First Cup



## We're Back to Mugging Guests!








Each evening we enjoyed a devotional led by Charley Ward, followed by hours of fun & fellowship. With each visit to the camp, our work eases the maintenance load for the camp staff greatly, not only for this upcoming season, but for many more years to come.






