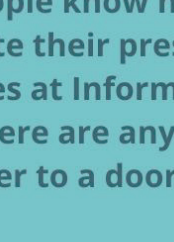

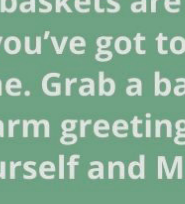
Mug a Guest
