

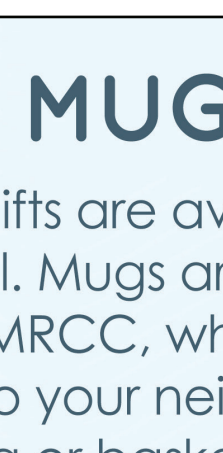

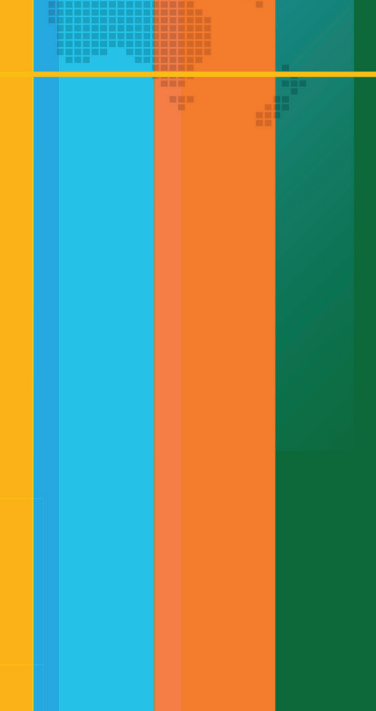
We meet at 9:35 in the Conference Room, which is located off the lobby near the rear entrances of the Auditorium

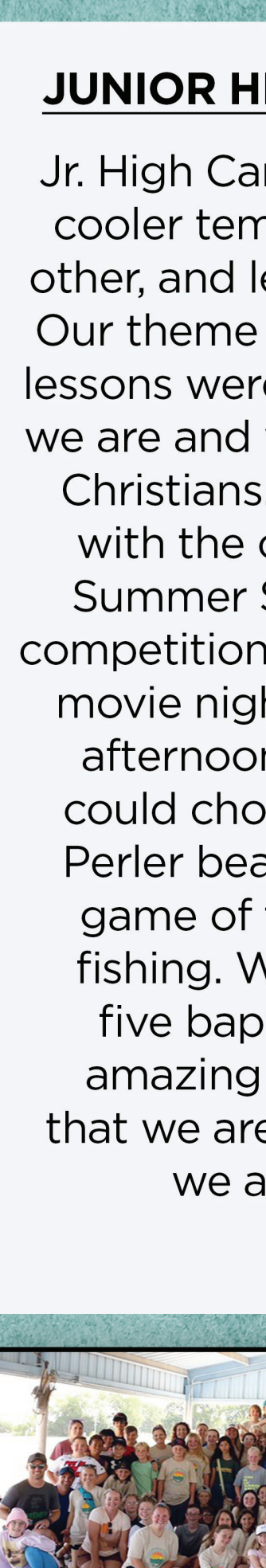
WOMEN'S SERVICE WEEK

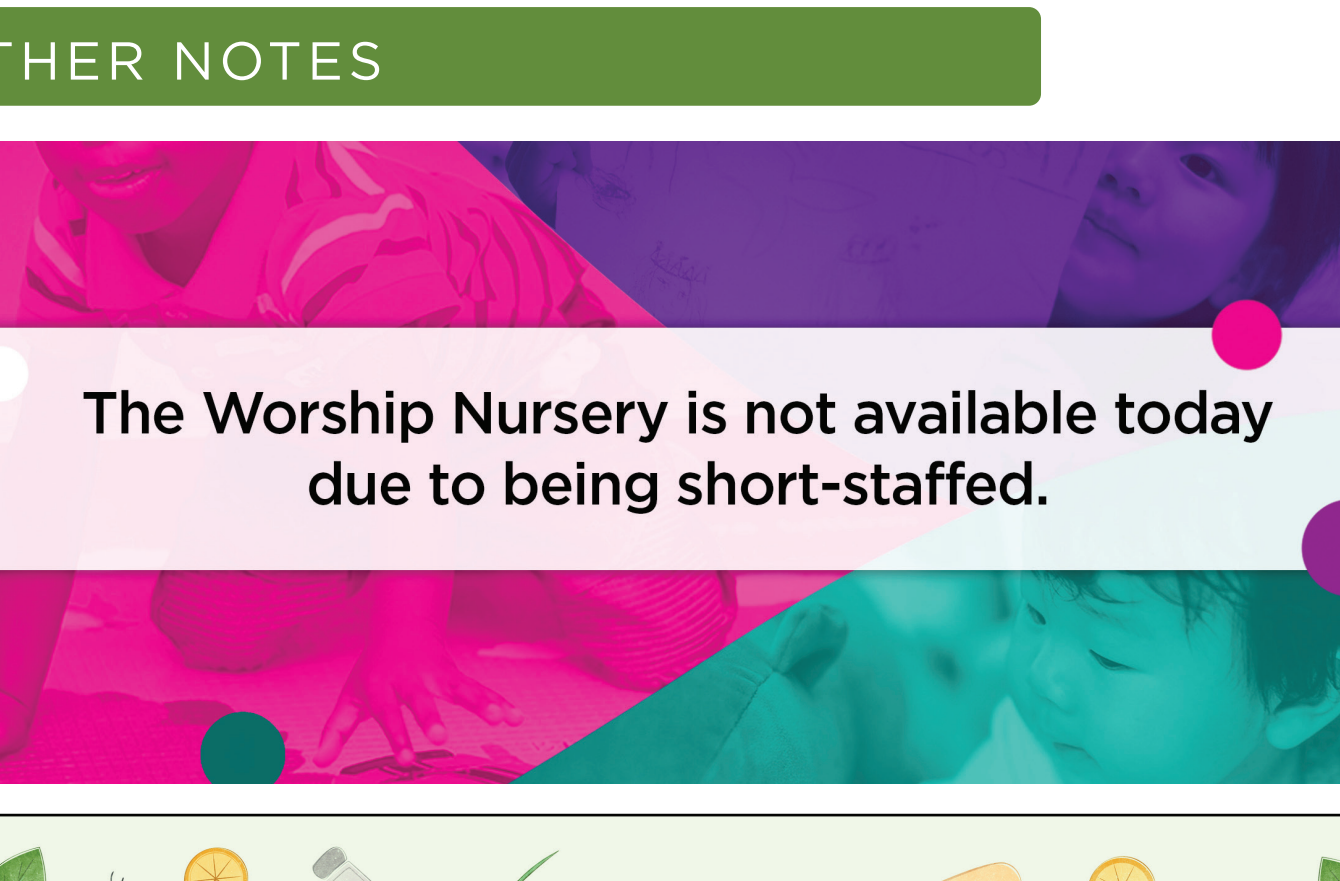

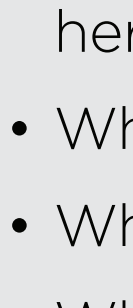

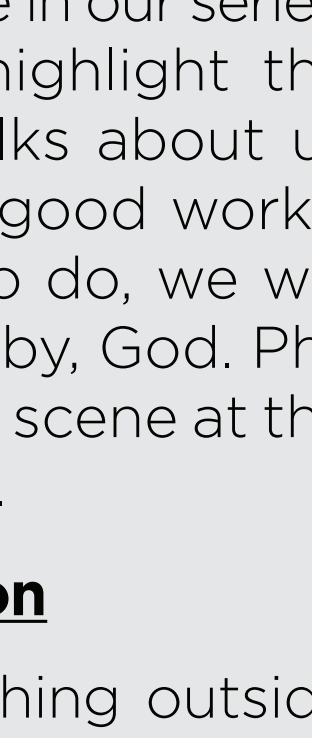

HOMEcoming

20 YEARS OF BRINGING GOOD NEWS



Today Phil will give the second message in our series, *Homecoming*. In this sermon, he'll highlight the next verse in Ephesians 2, which talks about us being created in Christ Jesus to do good works. When we do what we were made to do, we will find it easier to know, and be known by, God. Phil will also look at Peter's reinstatement scene at the end of John in relation to this theme.

Questions for Reflection & Discussion

- When was a time you used something outside its intended purpose?
- Rank knife, spoon, and fork in order of preference.
- Phil brought up two viewpoints toward reality, one being "causality" and the other "teleology." The first view asks the question "What caused this?" and the second view asks the question, "What is this here for?" How does each of these questions shape how one views and interacts with the world?
- Why do you think Jesus asked Peter if Peter loved him? Why do you think he asked him three times?
- John uses three different words for love in this passage. Do you think he had something in mind here, or was he simply using synonyms?
- What is a memory where you felt deeply loved?
- When was a memory where you shared love?
- Which prayer do you feel you need to pray more right now, Ephesians 3:17 or Philippians 1:9?
