

20 YEARS OF BRINGING GOOD NEWS



A few weeks ago when we announced our plans for the 20th Special Missions Contribution, I said “God always accomplishes more than we ever could plan or imagine.” From that, we listed three different levels of support: Tier 3 (the core programs of MRCC Missions), Tier 2 (programs we would like to expand to), and Tier 1 (which would include all requests that fit within our vision of mission outreach).

Once again, the generosity of Memorial Road—of you—is amazing and goes beyond just a donation and into the area of sacrifice and commitment to support mission outreach throughout the world. As of today, the total amount you have committed is **\$819,118.68** which represents a level of support that is close to the highest we have ever raised for missions! We are praying that we will soon move into the 2nd Tier of support, which will allow us to provide for all of the core ministry work but extends into works that we have dreamed of: Harvest Brazil—supporting Brazilian churches in the planning and planting of new congregations, led by Brazilians; Cuban Mission Team—supporting the planting of a new mission team from Cuban graduates of Baxter Institute, who will return to their own people to bring the Gospel. So much of our prayers going into this year’s contribution has been focused on finding ways to engage more people who can serve in their own nations and culture—rather than having North Americans who need to learn culture and language—to immediately be prepared to teach and preach. This is being answered by your sacrificial giving.

We hope you were touched by Sunday’s activities. Inspired by the lives of all of the missionaries who are a living part of MRCC. Personally, I was overwhelmed by looking into the eyes and faces of all of those on the stage who have served and who were able see how much we appreciated the sacrifices and hard work that Phil spoke of in his message. Sunday’s service seemed to have a feel that took me back to the early days of the Special Missions Contribution: amazing singing, tremendous preaching and a spiritual nature which connected us to the real reasons for having a day like this—to honor God, to sacrificially give into His Kingdom and to support those who are willing to go and serve.


Thank you for making 20 Missions Sundays memorable and full of love for those who need to know of God’s everlasting love.


TODAY’S GUEST SPEAKERS




MINISTRY UPDATES




