

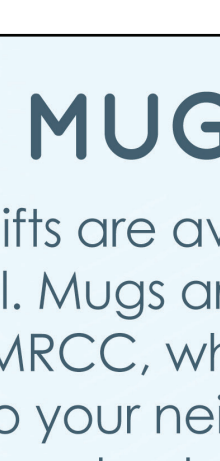

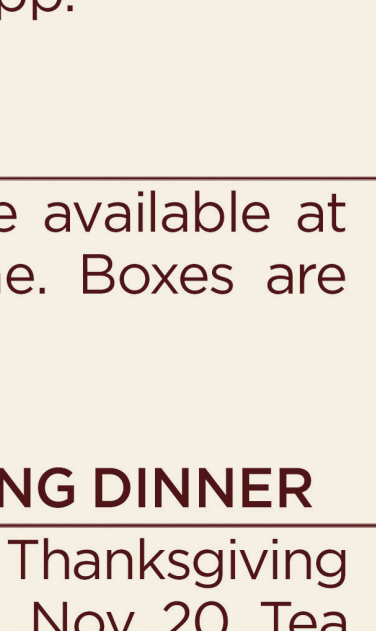
FIRST CUP IS A CHANCE FOR NEWCOMERS TO LEARN MORE ABOUT MEMORIAL ROAD

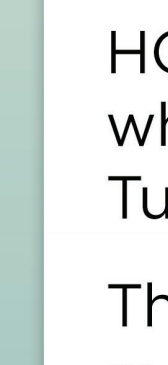
INTERNATIONAL THANKSGIVING DINNER

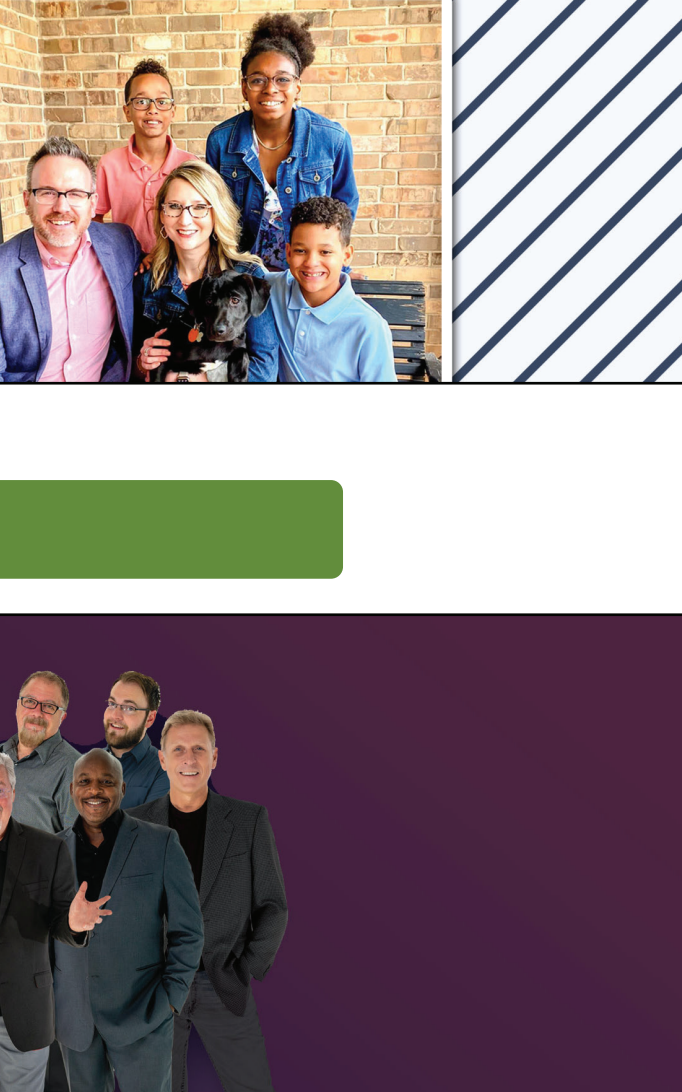
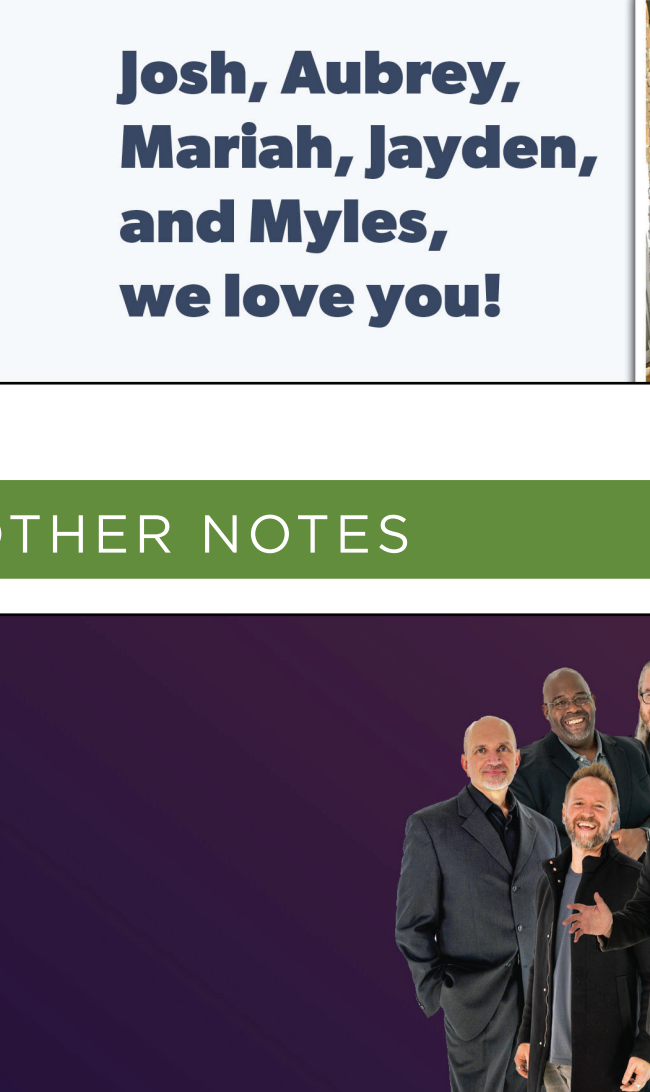

Blessed are you, O God, for You have created the wide and wonderful world in which we live.

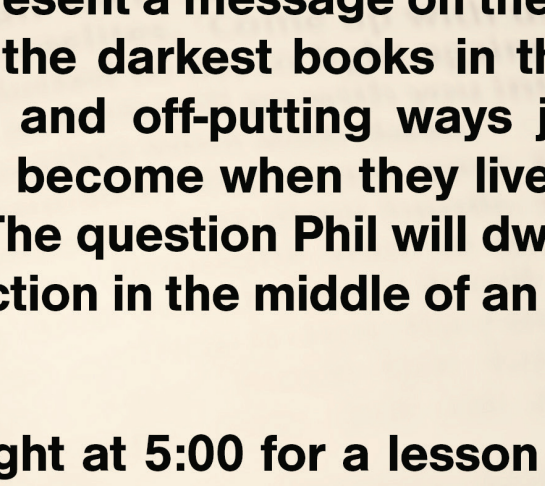
Please hold the Kingcade family securely in Your hands as they follow Your call to a new place.
