

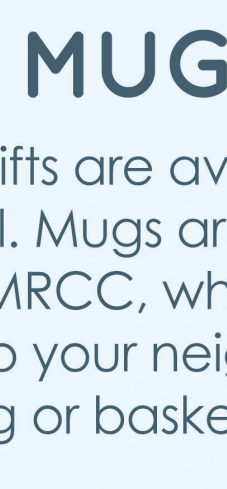

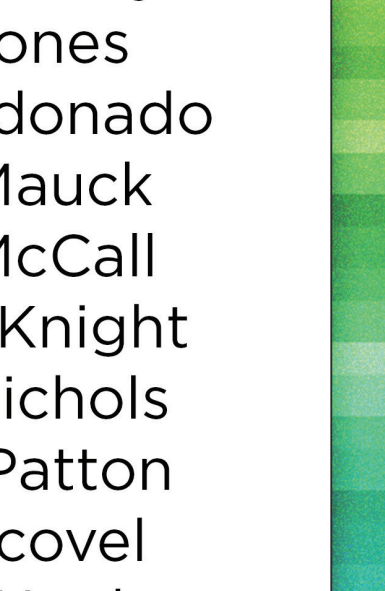

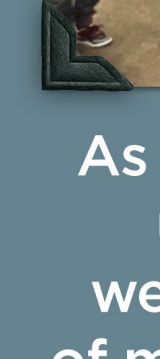

THANKSGIVING DAY IN THE CITY

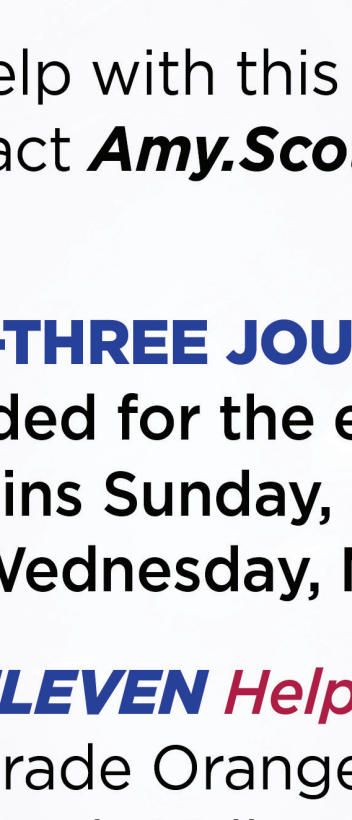

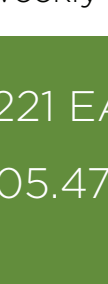
Sympathy
