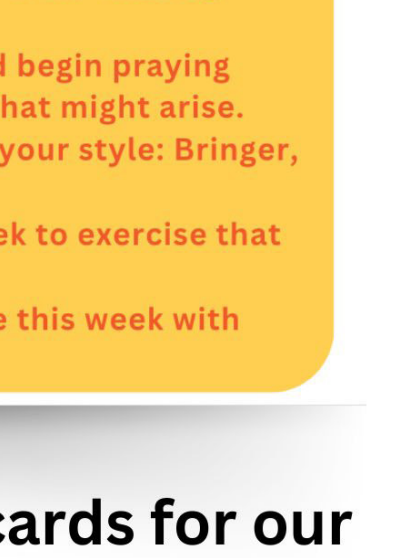

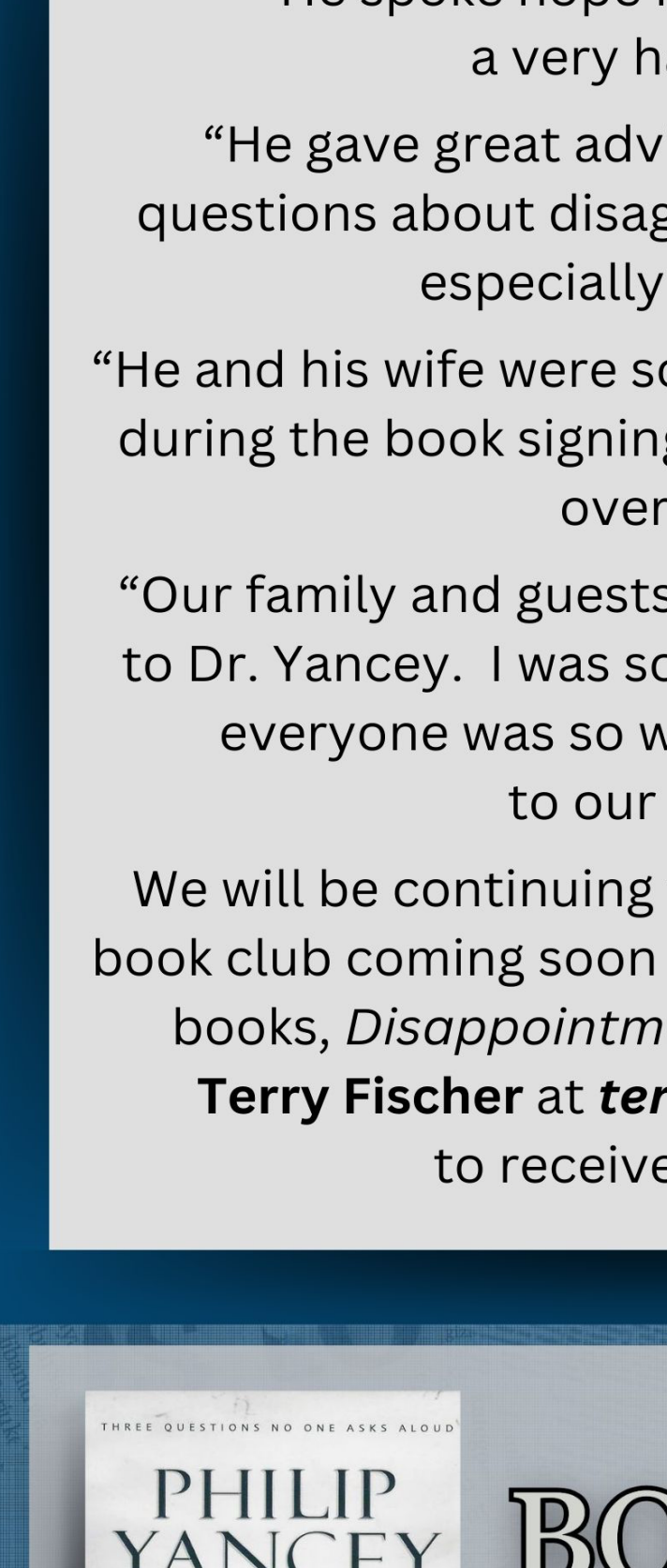

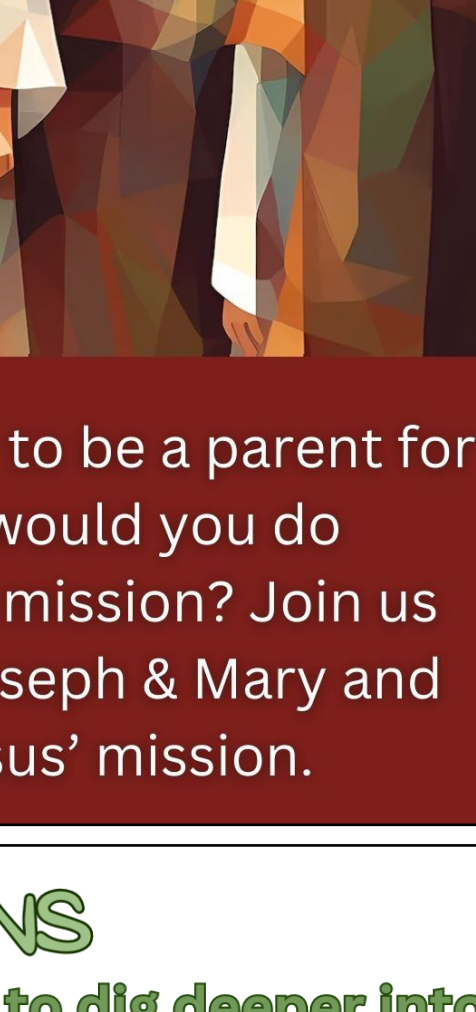
NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER THURSDAY, MAY 2

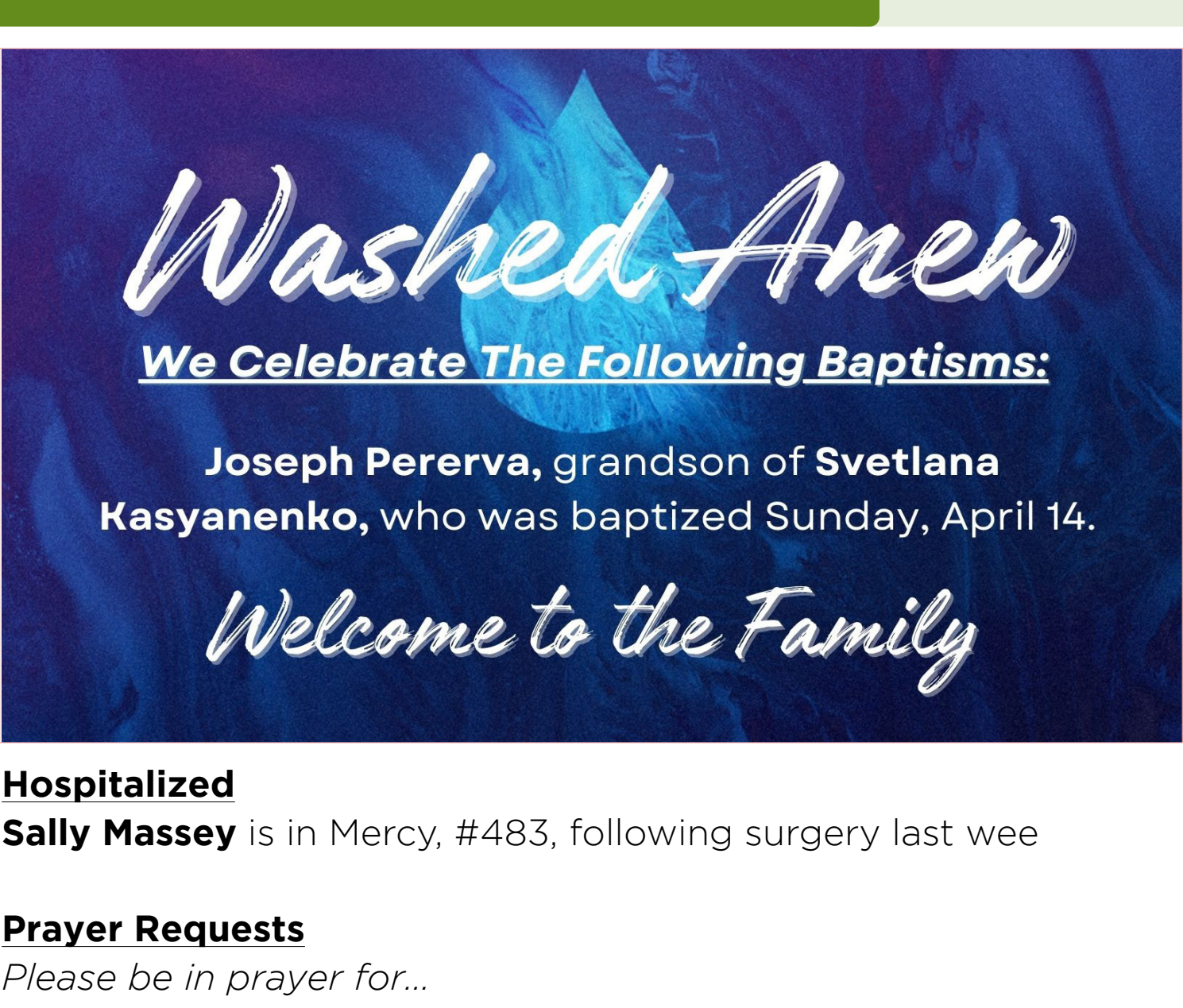

THE MISSION OF JESUS

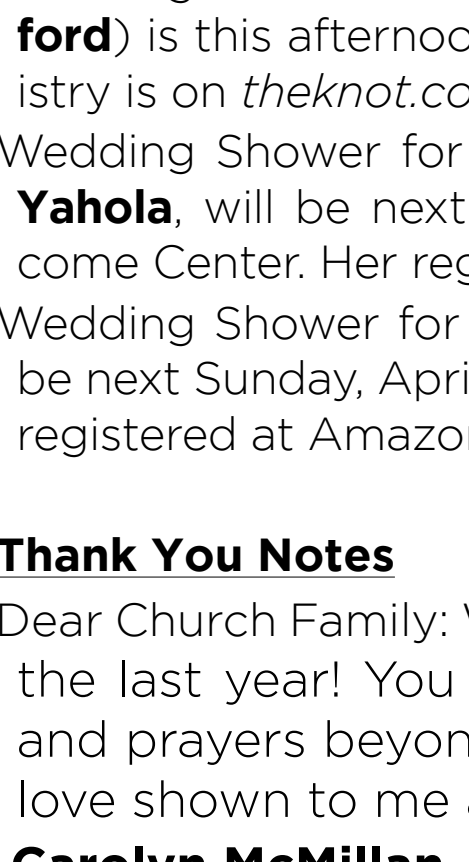

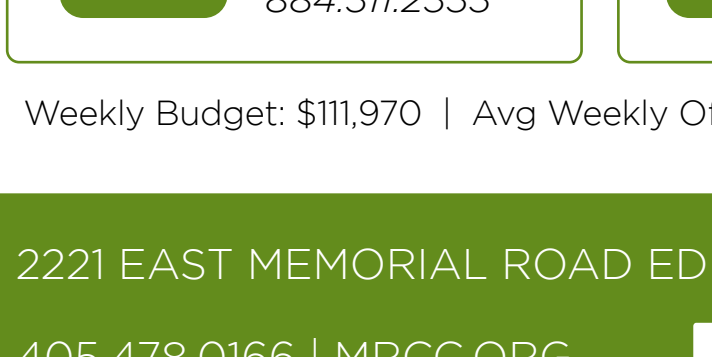
