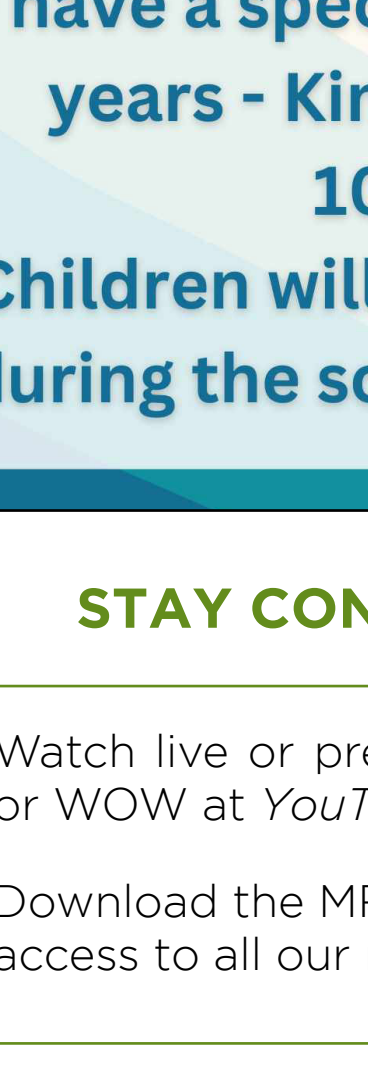
SERMON INFO

Today, Phil will continue our Like Stars in the Sky sermon series with a message entitled Grow with Interest.
