

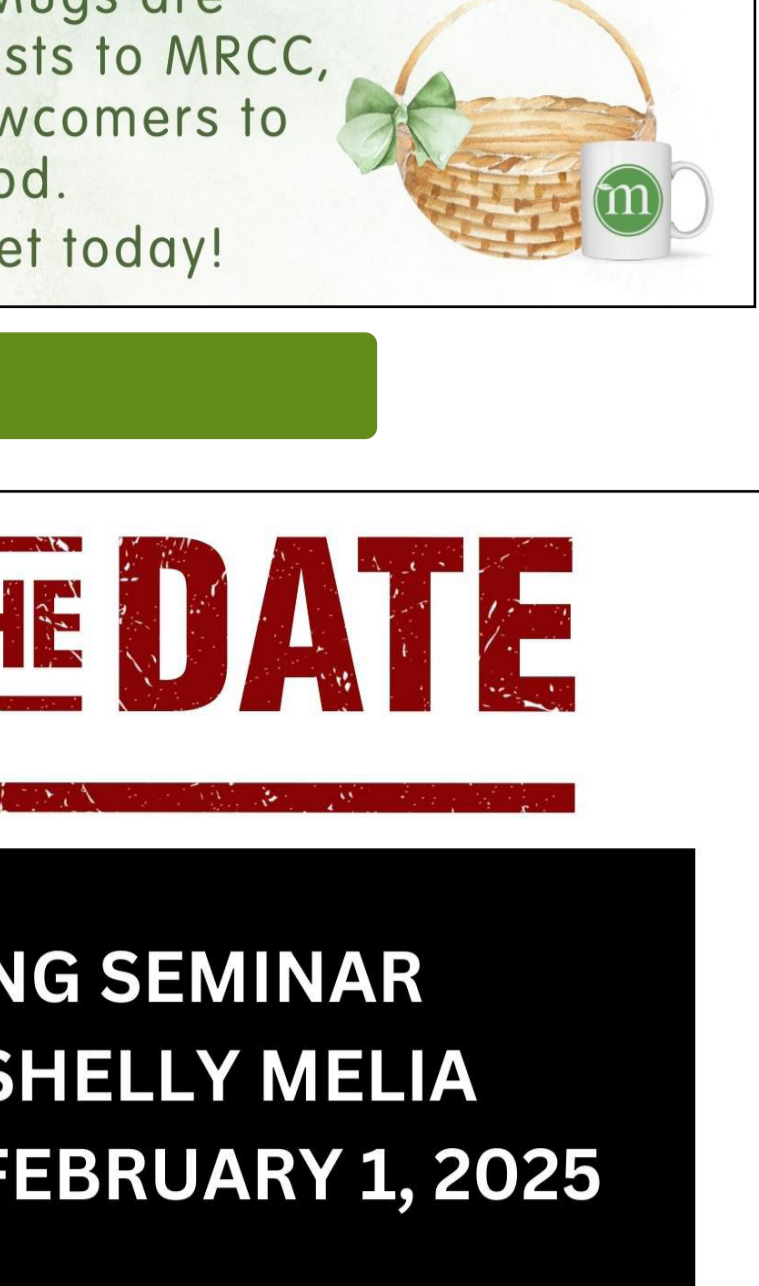

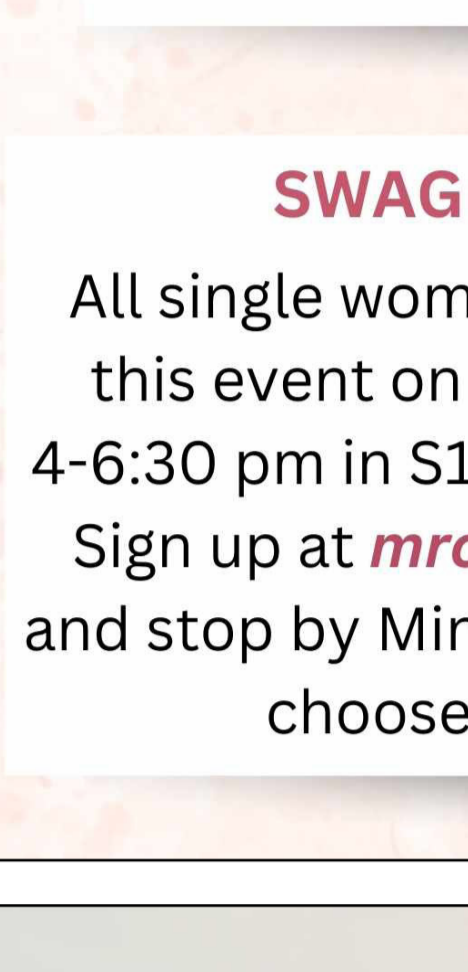

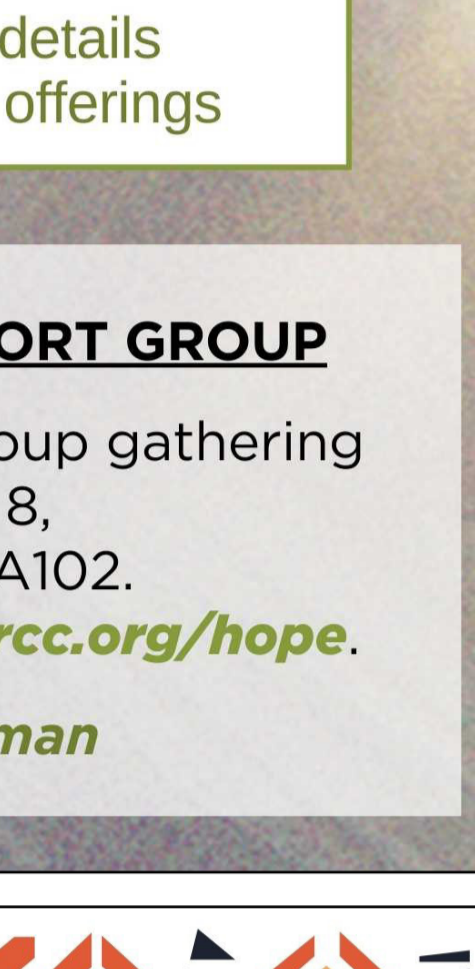


THREADS OF COMPASSION

WORD ON THE STREET RECAP

We had a great weekend of service centered around the theme of blessing children. A big thank you to all who served in a project or who donated needed items. Volunteers from MRCC made and delivered beds for children who needed them, prepared freezer meals for families fostering children and single-parent families, partnered with Lilyfield in several ways, helped Millwood schools, Angel Foster Family Network, Timothy Hill Ranch (children's home), and Infant Crisis Services. Some of what we gave was time, donated food items, and our labor. But here are some of the numbers of things we can count:

- Around 240 volunteers served over the weekend and SO MANY others donated items used in our projects.
- We delivered boxes of food items to feed 42 toddlers for a week and 120 healthy snack packs to Infant Crisis Services.
- 80 boxes of needed food items went to Lilyfield to assist the families they work with along with over 120 lbs of freezer meal contents to assist them in feeding the children in their programs.
- Around 50 care packages will go to residents of the Timothy Hill Ranch.
- 20 beds were built on Saturday by 35 volunteers and delivered on Sunday by another 20 volunteers working with Sleep in Heavenly Peace.

Thanks again to all of you who had a part in blessing children and honoring Jesus by letting your light shine in this community.

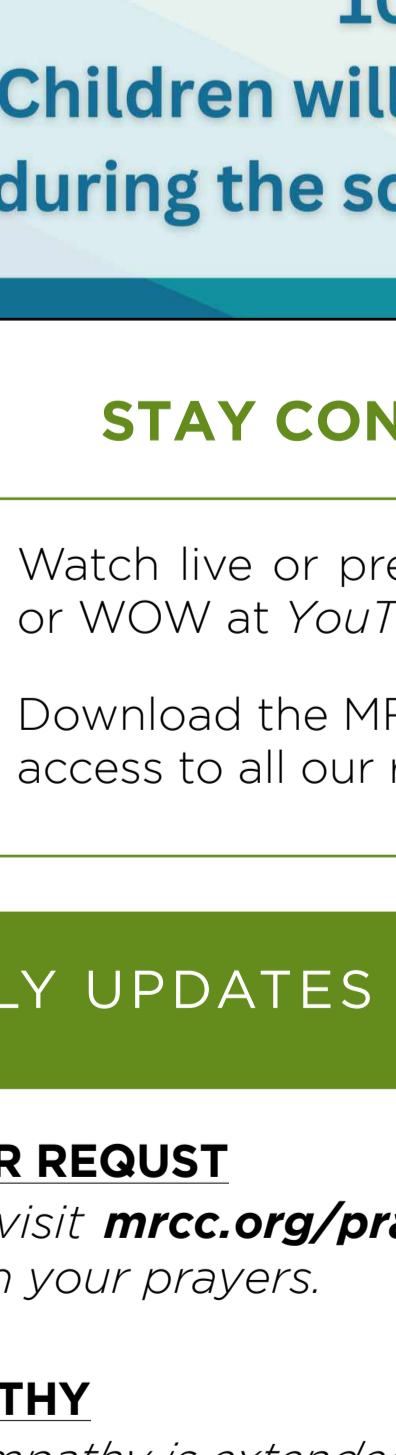
SEEK YE FIRST

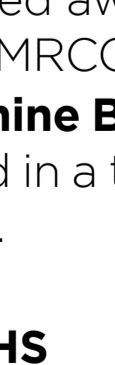

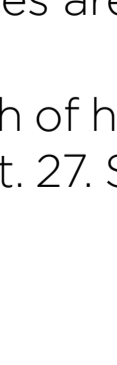
